



## **KAMCHATKA TERRITORY**

Kamchatka— subject of the Russian Federation. Included in the Far Eastern Federal District, is part of the Far Eastern Economic district. Administrative center - the city of Petropavlovsk-Kamchatsky.

It borders in the north-west with the Magadan region, in the north with the Chukotka Autonomous Okrug, in the south through the First Kuril Strait it borders with the Sakhalin region.



## **GEOGRAPHICAL POSITION**

The Kamchatka Territory is part of the Far Eastern Federal District and occupies the Kamchatka Peninsula with the adjacent mainland, as well as the Commander and Karaginsky Islands. The Kamchatka Territory borders in the north-west with the Magadan Region, in the north - with the Chukotka Autonomous Okrug, in the south - with the Sakhalin Region.

From the east, Kamchatka is washed by the waters of the Pacific Ocean, from the northeast - by the waters of the Bering Sea, from the west - by the waters of the Sea of Okhotsk.



## ***SYMBOLS, DAY***

The coat of arms of the Kamchatka Territory is quadrangular with rounded lower corners, heraldic pointed at the tip shield. Meaning of symbols: Volcanoes – business card Kamchatka. Rising sun and ocean indicate geographic location the edges. National ornament reflects folk art and history.



The flag of the Kamchatka Territory is a rectangular panel of two horizontal stripes: the upper one is white, the lower one is blue. The stripe width ratio is 2:1.

# NATURAL RESOURCES AND CLIMATE

The natural resources of the Kamchatka Territory are extremely rich and diverse: These are fish, forest, hunting, land, water, recreational, mineral and fuel and energy resources. The peninsula's most valuable energy, raw materials and resource resources are at the initial stage of development. The region has unique deposits of volcanic clay and pumice, zeolite and perlite.

The climate is mainly temperate monsoon, temperate continental in the center, subarctic in the north; the average temperature in January on the Kamchatka peninsula is  $-15.5^{\circ}\text{C}$ , in the adjacent part of the mainland  $-25^{\circ}\text{C}$ , the average temperature in July is  $+13.2^{\circ}\text{C}$ ; precipitation is up to 1000 mm per year.



## POPULATION

As of January 1, 2023, the population of the Kamchatka Territory, taking into account the All-Russian: 134 nationalities live in the region: Russians (85.9%) are the most numerous in the region, Ukrainians (3.9%) occupy the second place in terms of population, Koryaks (2.3%), Tatars, Belarusians, Itelmen, Chukchi, Evens, Koreans, etc.
