

REPUBLIC OF ADYGEA

It is part of the Southern Federal District and is part of the North Caucasus economic region. The capital is the city of Maykop.

Formed on July 27, 1922 as
Circassian autonomous region on the territory

STATE DEVICE CAPITAL

Government carried out:

1. State Council - Khase of the Republic of Adygea. This is the permanently operating highest and only legislative (representative) body of state power of the republic.
 2. Head of the Republic of Adygea. This is the highest official of the republic (the head of the highest executive body of state power).
 3. Government led by the Prime Minister.
- The municipal structure of the Republic of Adygea includes 2 urban districts (Maykop and Adygeisk) and 7 municipal districts.



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REPUBLIC SYMBOLS, ANTHEM, REPUBLIC DAY

Twelve stars on the flag- these are 12 Circassian tribes. Three crossed arrows - 3 princely families, which also symbolize earth, fire and water.

The coat of arms depicts a horseman with a quiver of arrows, a sword, in armor, and in his right hand he holds a torch. This horseman is the famous Sosruko. Hero of Nart ancient legends and legends.

On October 5, the Republic of Adygea will celebrate the 32nd anniversary of its formation.

The anthem of the Republic of Adygea is performed in the key of C minor. The text was written by the national writer Ishak Mashbash, and the music was written by Umar Thabisimov.

GEOGRAPHY

The republic is located in the southwest of the Russian Federation, on the left bank of the Kuban, occupies the central part of the Kuban inclined (Zakubanskaya) plain and the northern slopes of the Northwestern Caucasus.

The main territory of the republic is located in the basin of two main tributaries of the Kuban: the Laba and Belaya rivers and is located between parallels 44° and 45° N.

The area of Adygea is 7790 km². The length of the borders is 900 km. The length of the territory of the republic from north to south is 208 km, from west to east 165 km.



NATURAL RESOURCES, CLIMATE

Adygea is rich in forest resources, occupying more than a third of its territory in the southern part. Among the mineral resources, there are small reserves of natural gas, large reserves of building materials (gravel, sand, clay, limestone), and small deposits of gold and ore materials are located in the mountainous part of the republic.

The climate is moderately warm and mild. The nature of atmospheric circulation has a great influence on the formation of the climate of the region. An important climatic and recreational characteristic of the area is the duration of sunshine.



POPULATION

The population of the republic, according to Rosstat, is 497,985 people. Population density: 63.91 people/km² (2023). Urban population: 49.49%

The main population is Russians (64.5%) and Adygeis (24.2%). Other peoples inhabiting the republic include Armenians, Tatars, Belarusians, Ukrainians, Germans, Greeks and others.
