

STAVROPOL REGION

Stavropol Territory is a subject of the Russian Federation, part of the North Caucasus Federal District and the North Caucasus Economic Region. The regional center is the city of Stavropol. The area is 66,160 km². The population is 2,711.7 thousand people. The population density is 40.9 people/km², the share of the urban population is 56.9% .



GEOGRAPHICAL POSITION

Located in the central part of the Ciscaucasia and on the northern slope of the Greater Caucasus. Most of the territory of the Stavropol Territory is occupied by the Stavropol Upland, which passes in the east into the Terek-Kuma Lowland (Nogai steppe). In the north, the elevation merges with the Kuma-Manych depression. In the foothills zone, the Caucasian Mineral Waters region stands out with laccolithic mountains up to 1401 m high (Beshtau).





SYMBOLS DAY

The flag of the Stavropol Territory is a rectangular cloth of golden color with an image of a straight white cross on it. In the center of the cross there is a colored or monochrome image of the coat of arms of the Stavropol Territory, made in gold, the dimensions of which do not go beyond the white field of the crosshair. The coat of arms of the Stavropol Territory is a heraldic shield framed. It is divided horizontally into two parts. In the upper half, on a blue background, there is the main element of the historical coat of arms of Stavropol province, approved in 1878.

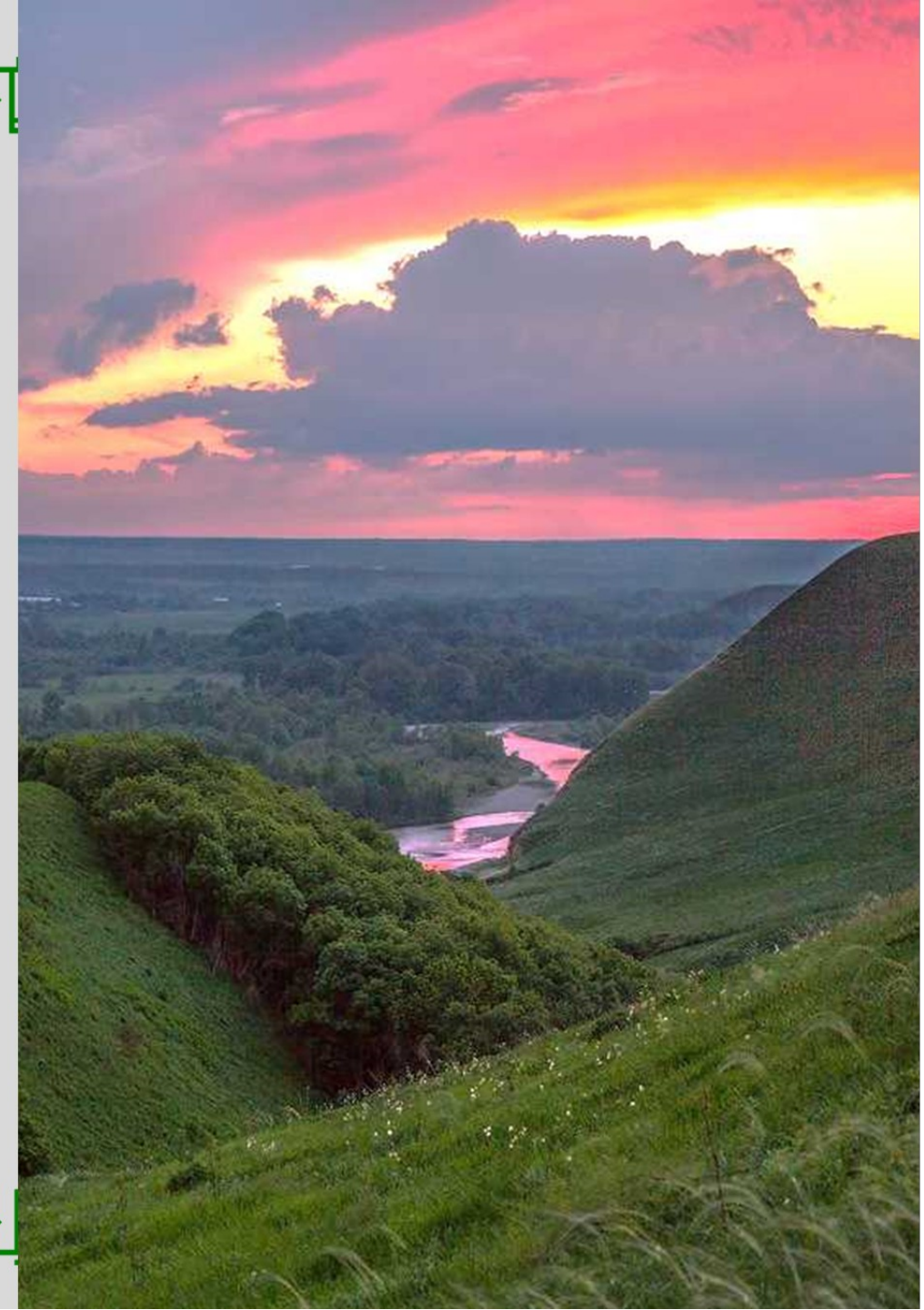

NATURAL RESOURCES AND CLIMATE

Minerals of the region: gas, oil, copper, polymetals, coal, building materials. The most famous deposits are: gas - Mirnenskoye, Sengileevskoye and Severo-Stavropol-Pelagiadinskoye; oil - Praskoveyskoye; copper - Urupskoye; polymetals - Elbrusskoye; coal - Khumarinskoye.

Stavropol Territory is located in a temperate continental climate zone, with prevailing east and west winds. The climate regime changes significantly throughout the year; the meteorological seasons of the year, as a rule, do not coincide with the calendar ones. Climate. The movement of moderate air masses prevails in the region. Air flows often penetrate from Kazakhstan, the Atlantic and the Arctic.





POPULATION

The population of the Stavropol Territory according to Rosstat is 2,886,108 people (2024). Population density - 43.62 people/km² (2024).

Representatives of more than 100 nationalities live on the territory of the Stavropol Territory.

Among them: Russians (81.6% of the population); Dargins; Nogais; gypsies; Karachais; Circassians; Chechens; Tatars; Ossetians; Avars; Kabardians; Lezgins; Kumyks; Tabasarans and others.

Also living in the region are Armenians, Ukrainians, Greeks, Azerbaijanis, Turkmen, Belarusians, Georgians, Germans, Turks, Koreans, Jews, Poles, Bulgarians, Estonians and others.
