The Exterior of a Car

The exterior of a car is what people see from the outside. It's important because it protects the inside of the car and the people in it.

The basic parts of the exterior are the front, back, and sides. The front has the hood, windshield, grill, headlights, and bumper. The back has the trunk, brake lights, and bumper. The sides have doors, mirrors, and sometimes windows.

The hood is at the front of the car. You open it to check the oil and water for the engine. The windshield is the front window. The wipers clean rain off the windshield. The grill is a metal part over the engine. It lets air into the engine. Headlights are at the front of the car. They light up the road at night. The bumper is a plastic or metal part at the front and back. It protects the rest of the car if there's an accident.

The trunk is at the back of the car. It's a big space for bags and other things. The brake lights are at the back of the car. They go on when you stop. The doors are on the sides. You open them to get in and out of the car. Mirrors are on the sides and sometimes the back. You use them to see behind and to the sides of the car. Windows are on the sides and sometimes the back. They let you see out of the car.

Some cars also have fenders, spoilers, and taillights. Fenders are on the sides above the wheels. They protect the wheels. Spoilers are on the back of some cars. They help keep the car on the road at high speeds. Taillights are at the back of the car. They go on when you turn on the lights.
