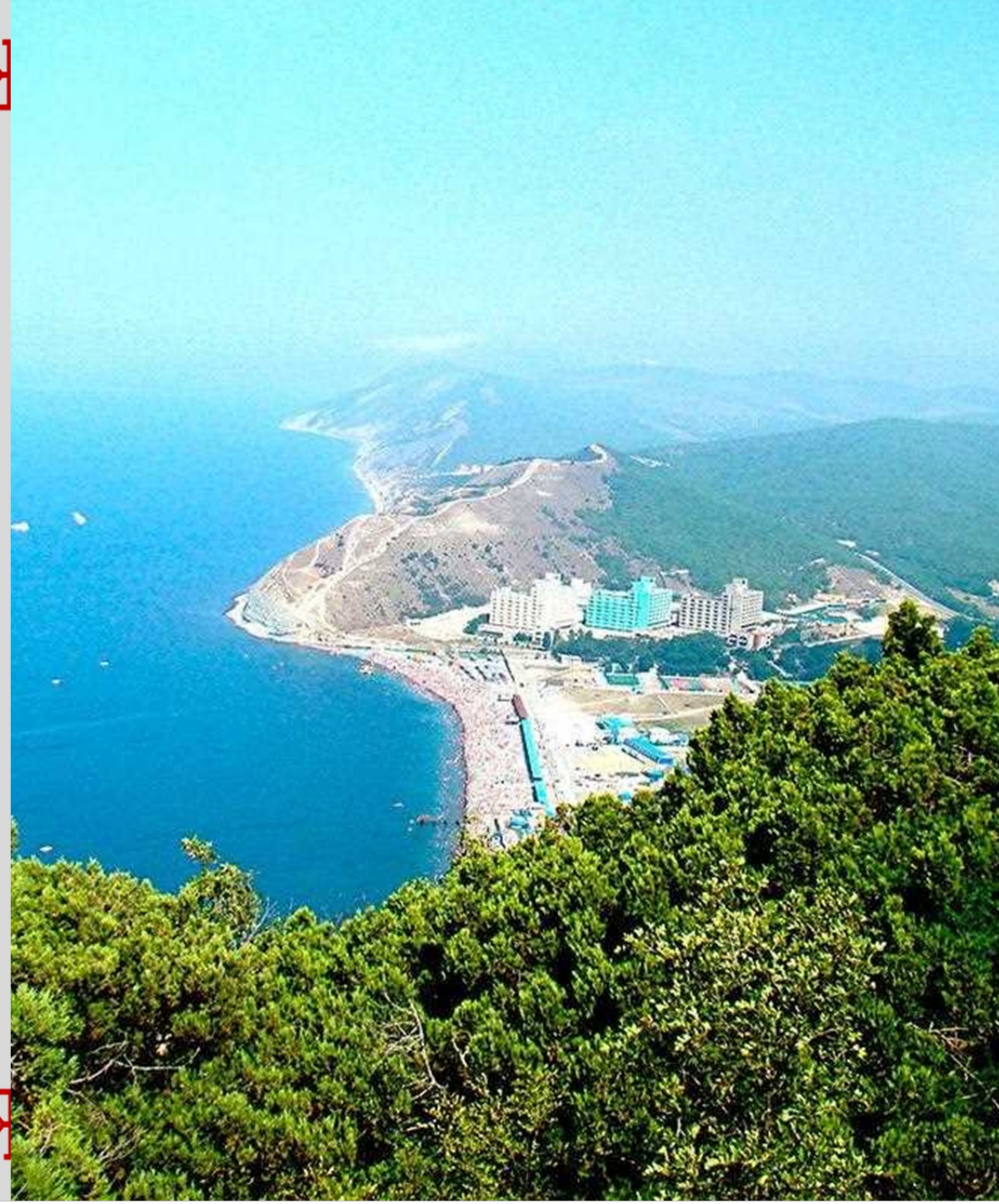


KRASNODAR REGION

A subject of the Russian Federation located in the south-west of the country. It is part of the Southern Federal District. It borders the Rostov Region, Stavropol Territory, Karachay-Cherkessia, Adygea and Abkhazia. It borders Crimea by sea through the Kerch Strait. The administrative center is the city of Krasnodar.



GEOGRAPHICAL POSITION

The region is located in the southwestern part of the North Caucasus, the 45th parallel divides it into approximately two equal parts. In the northeast, the region borders on the Rostov region, in the east - on the Stavropol Territory, in the south - on Abkhazia. From the northwest and southwest, the territory of the region is washed by the Azov and Black Seas. The total length of the region's borders is 1,540 km, of which 800 km by land and 740 km by sea.





SYMBOLS DAY

The modern interpretation of the flag of the Krasnodar Territory reflects, on the one hand, history, and on the other, combines the geographical component and the interpretation of colors traditionally accepted in heraldry. The blue stripe symbolizes the descendants of the Don and linear Cossacks. The blue color also symbolizes clear skies, expanses of water, honor and impeccability. The coat of arms of the Krasnodar region is based on the image of the historical coat of arms of the Kuban region of the Russian Empire.

NATURAL RESOURCES AND CLIMATE

There are reserves of oil, natural gas, marl, iodine-bromine waters, marble, limestone, sandstone, gravel, quartz sand, iron and apatite ores, rock salt.

The climate of the Krasnodar Territory is characterized by an excess of solar radiation with moderate hydration. Region is located in a temperate climate zone, but in the Azov region it also shows features of the sea, and in the Black Sea region - Mediterranean, especially in winter period. In the northeastern part is more continental. Western transport of air masses predominates.





POPULATION

The population of the Krasnodar Territory, according to Rosstat, is 5,833,002 people. (2024). The region ranks third among regions in terms of population Russian Federation.

According to the latest population census, the national composition of the population of the Krasnodar Territory is as follows:

Russians - 5,011,433 people (88.30%).

Armenians - 312,150 people (5.50%).

Ukrainians - 90,807 people (1.60%).

Other nationalities (less than 0.5% each) - 261,071 people (4.6%).
