Dismissal Policies in the Kindergarten

The authorized guardians of a child are the only people who can pick up the child from school. If someone other than the guardian is picking up the child, the parent or guardian must inform the school and provide a description of the person. The school will require identification from that person when they come to pick up the child.

At dismissal time, parents and guardians should wait outside the school building near the buses. They should not go directly to their child's classroom. This helps ensure an orderly dismissal process and prevents confusion.

Parents and guardians who drive their child to school should remain in their cars during dismissal. They should pull up to the curb in the designated area and wait for their child to be brought to them by a staff member.

If there is a change in the child's dismissal routine (for example, if the child is going home with a different relative), the parent or guardian must notify the school in writing or call the school office before 2:00 PM on the day of the change. The school will confirm the change with the parent or guardian over the phone before releasing the child.

During dismissal, students will line up in their classrooms and wait for their names to be called. When their name is called, they will walk with their teacher to the exit and wait for their parent or guardian to come get them.

If a parent or guardian arrives late for dismissal, they should report to the school office to sign out their child. The child will then be brought to the office by a staff member.

It is important that all parents and guardians follow these dismissal policies to ensure the safety and well-being of all students. If you have any questions or concerns about the dismissal process, please contact the school office.
