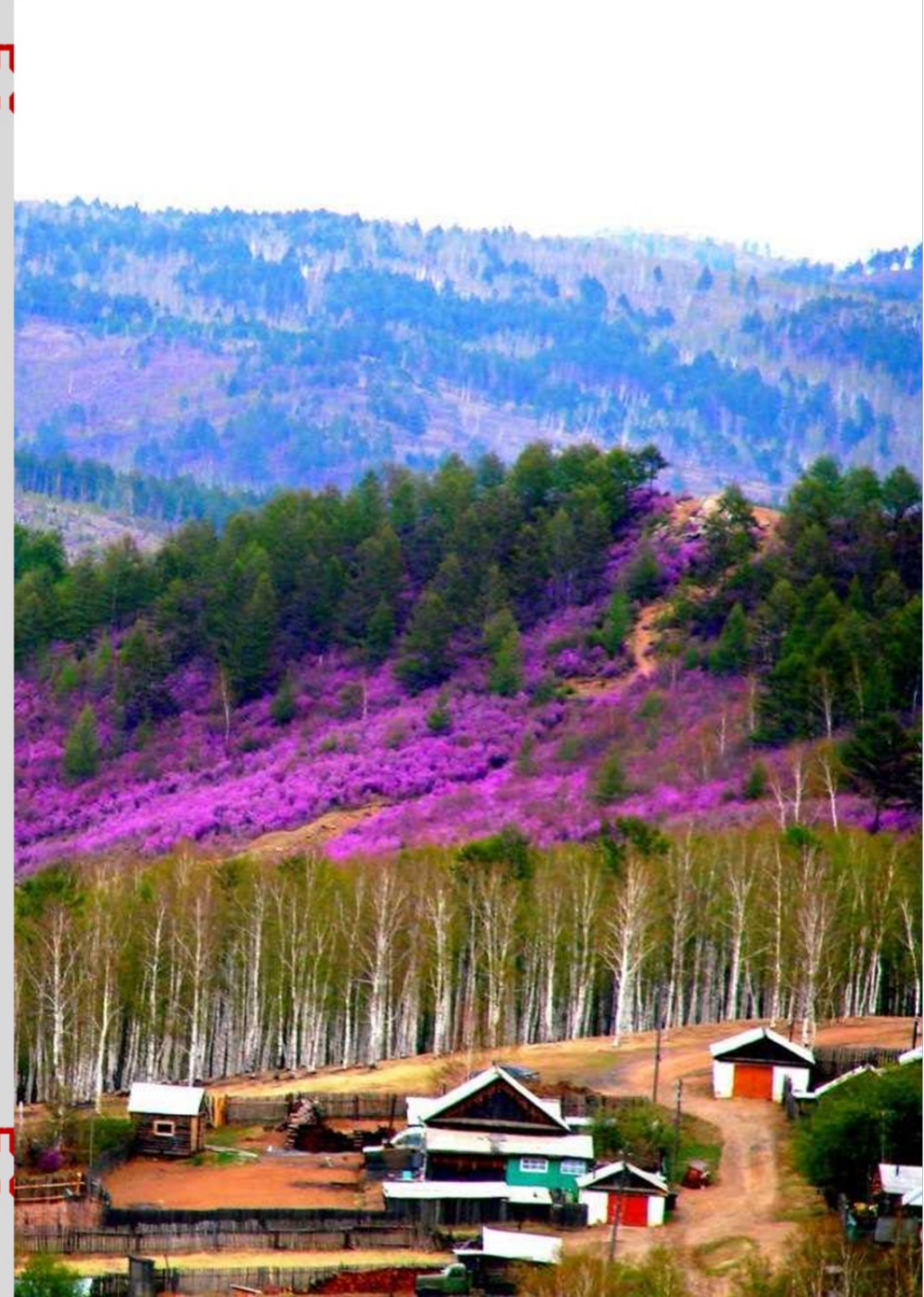


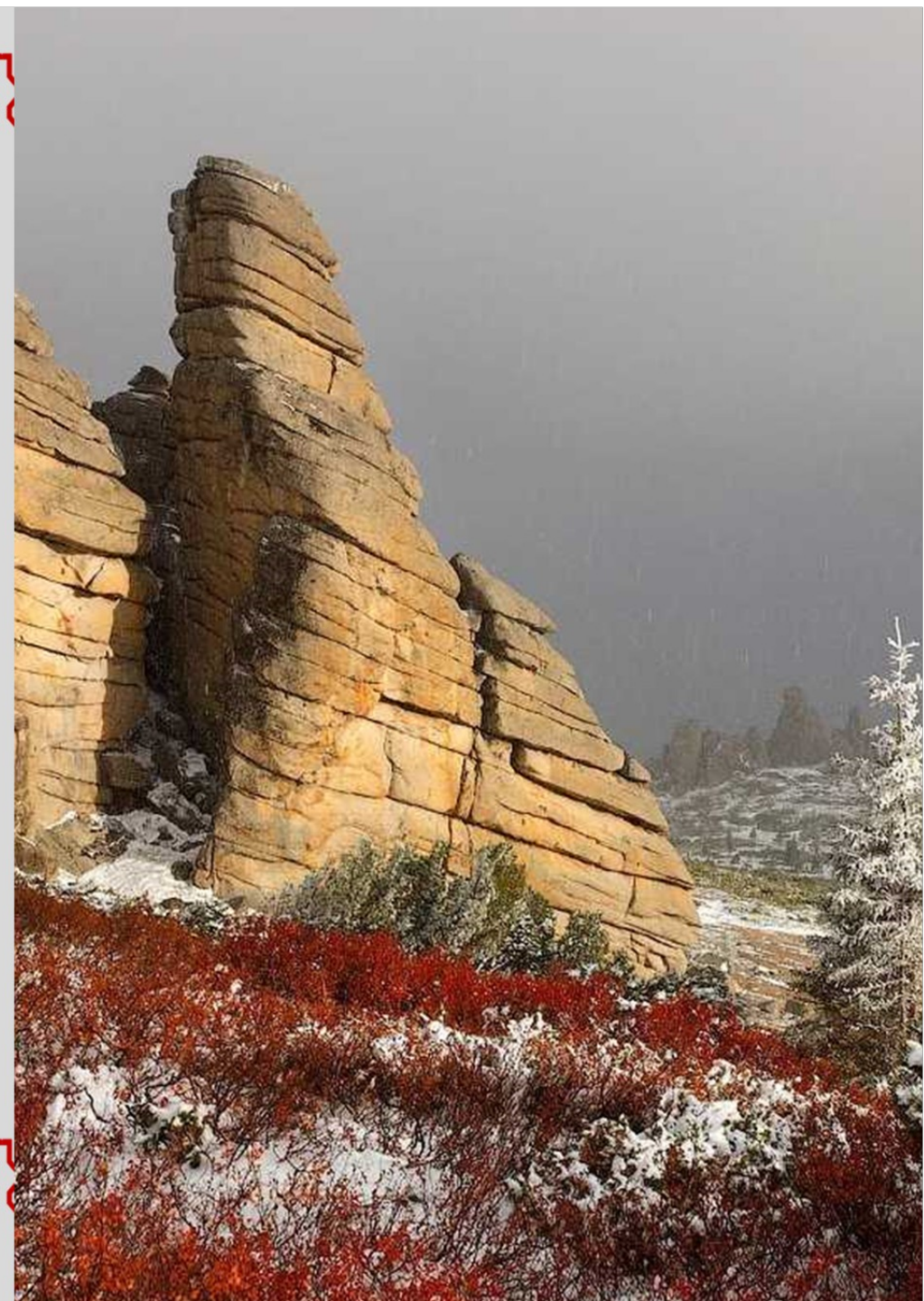
TRANSBAIKAL REGION

Zabaikalsky Krai (informally Transbaikalia) is a subject of the Russian Federation located in the eastern part of Transbaikalia, as part of the Far Eastern Federal District. It is part of the Far Eastern Economic Region. The administrative center is the city of Chita. The area of the territory is 431,892 km², which is 2.52% of the area of Russia. According to this indicator, the region ranks 12th in the country.



GEOGRAPHICAL POSITION

The Trans-Baikal Territory is located in the southeastern part of Eastern Siberia. The large extent of the region from north to south determined the presence of three latitudinal natural zones: taiga, forest-steppe and steppe. The relief of the Trans-Baikal Territory is represented by both plains and mountains, but mountains are noticeably predominant in the region. The northern part is occupied by mountain ranges, the middle zone is occupied by numerous hunting grounds, and the southern part is occupied by vast steppe plains. In total, 65 mountain ranges and 50 depressions were identified in the region.





SYMBOLS DAY

The colors of the flag repeat the main colors of the coat of arms of the Trans-Baikal Territory, symbolizing the natural features of the region: yellow - boundless steppe; green - taiga, rich fauna; red - energy-containing subsoil.

The scarlet (red) color symbolizes courage, bravery, intrepidity, green (green) color symbolizes hope, joy, abundance, Gold is a symbol of wealth, justice, silver is a symbol of goodness, independence. The coat of arms is drawn up according to heraldic rules and is made in the style of the historical symbolic heraldic system. It is a unique monument of the history and culture of the region.

NATURAL RESOURCES AND CLIMATE

The natural resources of the Trans-Baikal Territory include deposits and manifestations of combustible minerals, ferrous and non-ferrous metals, rare and precious metals, radioactive metals, mining and chemical raw materials, jewelry and ornamental stones, building materials and groundwater.

The climate is sharply continental. Winter is long and there is little snow. Spring and autumn are short. Summers are short and warm, dry in the first half and humid in the second. The average temperature in July is +13°C in the north and +20.7°C in the south. The frost-free period is 80-140 days.

A characteristic feature of the climate of Transbaikalia is the significant duration of sunshine per year - from 1873 to 2592 hours. From 200 to 600 millimeters of precipitation falls annually.





POPULATION

The population of the Trans-Baikal Territory, according to Rosstat, is 984,395 people. (2024). Population density - 2.28 people/km² (2024). Urban population - 70.39% (2022).

National composition: Russians - 89.9%, Buryats - 6.8%, Ukrainians - 0.6%.
