











- The purpose of the holiday was to bring attention to the importance of promoting children's rights and welfare around the world.
- It was originally celebrated on different days in various countries, but in 1954, the International Democratic Federation of Women proposed that June 1st be recognized as International Children's Day worldwide.
- Since then, the holiday has been observed annually in countries around the globe.
- In 1959, the United Nations General Assembly adopted the Declaration of the Rights of the Child, which recognized the importance of promoting and protecting the rights of children.




