

PERM KRAI


Perm Krai is a subject of the Russian Federation located in the east of the European part of Russia. It is part of the Volga Federal District and the Ural Economic Region. It was formed on December 1, 2005 as a result of the merger of the Perm Territory and the Komi-Permyak Autonomous Okrug following a referendum on December 7, 2003 (before that, there was a smaller Perm Territory). It is located at the entrance to the Perm Territory. The area of the Perm Territory is 160,236 km². Population: 2,635,849



GEOGRAPHICAL POSITION

Perm Krai is located in the east of the East European Plain and the western slopes of the Middle and Northern Urals, at the junction of two parts of the world - Europe and Asia. The length of the Perm Territory from north to south is almost 650 km, and from west to east - 420 km. The region borders the Komi Republic in the north, the Kirov Region and the Udmurt Republic in the west, the Republic of Bashkortostan in the south, and the Sverdlovsk Region in the east.





SYMBOLS DAY

The flag is a rectangular panel divided by a white cross into four equal rectangles of blue and red colors. Red symbolizes courage, bravery, readiness to defend the Fatherland.

The coat of arms of the Perm region is a shield of the French heraldic form of red color, in the center of which there is a polar bear, above which is the Gospel and a white eight-pointed star.



NATURAL RESOURCES AND CLIMATE

The Perm Region has significant reserves of natural resources. More than 1,000 deposits of almost 50 types of minerals have been identified and fossils have been explored. Main resources: oil and gas, potassium-magnesium and sodium salts, precious and ornamental stones, gold and platinum, chromites and other precious stones, metallurgical and cement raw materials, carbonaceous materials for the chemical industry, common minerals, underground fresh and mineral waters.

The climate of the Perm region is temperate continental. The average monthly temperatures of the coldest month of January are -15°C...-17°C, the warmest month of July is +15°C...+18°C. Winters are snowy and long, summers are moderately warm.





POPULATION

According to Rosstat, the population of the region is 2,556,852 people. (2022). Population density - 15.96 people/km² (2022). Urban population - 77.16%.

The predominant people of the Kama region are Russians (84%), the most numerous are Tatars (4.9%), Komi-Permyaks (4%), Bashkirs (1.6%), Ukrainians (1.5%), Udmurts (1%), Belarusians (0.5%), Germans (0.5%).
